## Bohemian rhapsody

**N**amed in the 1930s by a group of Bohemian writers who met at the Fitzroy Tavern, Fitzrovia was home to names such as Virginia Woolf, George Bernard Shaw and Arthur Rimbaud throughout the 20th century. The area still enjoys a reputation as an artsy, laidback and stylish London quarter, and the latest development to launch onto the market, The Fitzbourne, reflects this panache.
